- Coordinates the effort to identify fully the type and cost of services and equipment that will enable the catastrophically injured individual to function at maximum potential.

The Certified Life Care Planner

- Starts by reviewing the patient's medical, therapeutic, and educational records, and then conducts a face-to face interview with the patient.
- Contacts the patient's key care providers and appropriate vendors to ascertain cost, frequency, and replacement schedule taking into consideration life expectancy.

The finished product will be:

- A comprehensive medical history
- Detailed charts outlining specific costs
- Lifetime cost projection range
